USDA Forest Service and Mt. Hood Meadows Insurance Requirements

The following insurance guidelines are provided to show why insurance requirements are necessary and how the Certificate of Insurance needs to be prepared to meet the agency direction

Name on insurance policy must match name on this permit

The Special Use Permit requires the Permittee to indemnify the United States and Mt. Hood Meadows OREG., LLC against any liability for damage to life or property arising from the occupancy or use of National Forest System Lands. The Permit requires the Permittee to have the insurance company name the United States Government (Forest Service) and Mt. Hood Meadows OREG., LLC as additionally insured parties on a non-contributory basis. Also, the Certificate of insurance and the insurance policy shall contain a specific provision to the effect that the policy shall not be cancelled or the provisions changed or deleted before thirty (30) days written notification by the insurance company to the U.S. Government, c/o USDA Forest Service

A Certificate of Insurance must be presented to the Forest Service and Mt. Hood Meadows before a Special Use Permit will be issued.

The name on Insurance certificate must match name on permit application

It is understood and agreed that the coverage under this policy will not be changed or its provisions changed or deleted before thirty (30) days written notice to the United States Government, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Supervisor, Mt. Hood National Forest, 16400 Champion Way, Sandy, Or. 97055

It is understood and agreed that the "United States Government and Mt. Hood Meadows OREG., LLC is additionally insured on a non-contributory basis" solely as respects liability arising from operations of the named insured. The following acceptable additional insured clause shall be shown in verbatim on the face of the Certificate of Insurance or Binder and, as a clause or an endorsement in the policy "United States Government and Mt. Hood Meadows OREG., LLC is additionally insured on a non-contributory basis"

"Mt. Hood Meadows, OREG., LLC and The United States Government c/o USDA Forest Service Mt. Hood National Forest, ATTN: Mel Toney PO BOX 470 Mt. Hood, Or. 97041" shall be listed in the certificate holder box.

If these clauses are not on the Certificate of Insurance in verbatim, and are not in the insurance policy or on an endorsement as stated above, a Special Use Permit will not be issued.

The amount of insurance required will depend on the degree of risk involved. The Forest Representative administering the special use permit will inform the prospective permittee of the required liability coverage necessary, such as:

(coverage's shown minimums) (split \$100k/\$1mil/\$2mil) (\$2mil. CSL)

- (1) \$ 100,000 Property Damage
- (2) \$1,000,000 Death or injury to One Individual, and
- (3) \$2,000,000 Death or injury to more than One Individual
- (4) \$2,000,000 Combined Single Limit (CSL)
