

**2020 - 2021 Winter Season
Overnight Parking Rules/Regulations/Guidelines**

1. Pick-up truck campers, camping trailers, and RVs will be permitted to park in the parking lot in the designated Sunrise Parking Lot area and in strict accordance with the rules and regulations below.
2. One vehicle may accompany RV, camper or trailer.
3. Overnight parking in the Sunrise Lot is very limited and can only be administrated on a first come first served basis.
4. An RV must be registered with MHM Parking Dept. Registration form can be found at this link. www.skihood.com/plan-a-trip/transportation-options/overnight-rv-parking
5. Maximum 3 consecutive night stay allowed within any 5 night period.
6. Tents are not allowed.
7. To ensure cars are associated with self-contained vehicles (RV, camper, trailer) MHM prohibits sleeping in passenger vehicles.
8. Overnight RV vehicles must be fully self-contained for water, wastes, fuel, and garbage.
9. All garbage is the responsibility of the Guest. Garbage must not be left outside of the campers or RV. Pack out what you pack in.
10. Open fires are not permitted.
11. Quiet hours are from 10PM to 8AM.
12. RV idling hours, and/or gas powered generator use are from 8AM to 10PM only.
13. All water or liquid must be contained from depositing on the parking lot or adjacent snow or ground surfaces.
14. Pets must use the Doggie Park on the North Side of the Parking Lot, and otherwise be on leash and secured at all times.
15. Sledding is not allowed at MHM.
16. Overnight users may be required to move their vehicle at any time, night or day, for snow removal or other purposes at the discretion of MHM.
17. A restroom is located at the Overnight Parking Area.
18. 1st violation = written warning / 2nd violation = suspended from overnight RV parking at MHM for the season.
